



Oakleigh Grammar Students Driving Cars

Year 12 students wishing to drive to and from school must inform the Deputy Principal and must abide by the following stipulations outlined in the School's Riding or Driving to School Policy.

Student drivers must abide by the following stipulations:

- The car may be used only as a means of transport to and from Oakleigh Grammar at the beginning and the end of the day, or when privileges have been granted for Year 12s to leave campus during the day.
- Only one other student, who is at least 16 years of age but less than 22 years of age, is allowed as a passenger, unless a parent is sitting beside the driver.

The parents of any Oakleigh Grammar student passenger must provide written permission to the Deputy Principal.

- One sibling is permitted if they are the only other passenger, unless driving with a full licenced driver sitting beside the driver. Details of siblings should be indicated on the form.
- It is understood that Oakleigh Grammar is in no way liable for the student as he/she travels to and from school, including any passengers.
- The Students Driving Cars form has been completed, signed by a parent/guardian and submitted to the Deputy Principal.
