



Oakleigh Grammar Students Riding Bicycles

Students wishing to ride their bicycles to and from school must inform the Deputy Principal and must abide by the stipulations outlined in the School's Riding or Driving to School Policy.

Students are permitted to ride their bicycle to school under the following stipulations:

- Children under the age of 12 may ride on footpaths, as can a supervising adult. They are required to give way to pedestrians and to wheel their bicycles over pedestrian and children's crossings.

Children aged 12 years or older are required by law to ride on the road.

- Road safety authorities recommend that children under the age of 9 are supervised by an adult when riding on the road. Depending on their cycling skills and experience, some children over this age may still require supervision.

Whilst an area is provided for student bicycles, the school is not responsible for any loss or damage.

Helmets – as per the Victorian law, all cyclists must wear an approved bicycle helmet.

Students may not ride their bicycles in school grounds or in the area immediately outside the gates along Willesden Road.
